

Board of Directors Election for 2014

With the start of the new year for the Friends of the Youngstown Free Library, we began with the annual meeting on January 15th. At the meeting, we welcomed new officers and directors to our board, and parted with some dedicated directors whose terms had concluded. Those elected included our new secretary, Heidi Lauger, and two new directors, Faith Koch and Philip Miller.

Officers of the 2014 board elected at the January annual meeting are: Charlotte Clark, president; Lynn Funk, vice president; Heidi Lauger, secretary; and Bill Siddall, treasurer. Re-elected directors are Jessica Streb, Tom Patrick, Sue Larrabee, Christine Foster, David Brooks and Steve Bowen. Library trustee Maggie Steyn continued in the position of liaison to the Friends board.

Thank you to everyone for volunteering their time and energy to the Friends Board.

With much gratitude for their hard work and support over the past six years, we said goodbye to Judy Kay and Ed McGreevy. Judy's newspaper background made her invaluable when helping with our media relations and press-release bulletins and Ed was a visible volunteer at all of our fundraisers and was particularly pro-active in his efforts to reach out to new residents with informational packets of material about the library and the Friends. 2013 In Review

The year 2013 was a very good one for the Friends of the Youngstown Free Library. Our fundraisers grossed more than \$8,500, which was 28 percent higher than in 2012.

As a result, approximately \$7,000 was spent on library gifts and projects in 2013. These included: the new book drop and book truck, a family membership to Old Fort Niagara, a Leapfrog device, a Book Page subscription, a Playaway audio books subscription, child and adult summer reading programs, the 1000 Books Before Kindergarten program, Kindergarten library visits, a Young Authors program and the holiday candy guess.

We also raised \$15,535 for the library through the annual Library Fund Drive. This money goes directly into the library's account.

The difference between our 'income' and 'expenses' - approximately \$1,500 in 2013 - is used to pay for fundraising expenses. These include envelopes, postage, brochures, letters, newsletters and labels.

We are thankful to the generous and supportive Youngstown community, especially those who volunteered for us in 2013. We hope you will keep your membership active and your voice heard in a continued effort to support our Youngstown Free Library in 2014.

Bandana's scores another touchdown for the library!

Thank you to Bandana's Bar & Grill for holding a Chili Cook-Off benefit for the library on Super Bowl Sunday. Tickets for Tastings were sold at \$3 each and our host Melissa Kudel organized a raffle & a 50/50 draw. Nearly 60 people sampled some 10 different chili recipes and by the end, a massive \$420 had been raised for the library. More of this fun event's success in the next newsletter.

'Billiards for Books' Report - October 19th, 2013

The third 'Billiards for Books' event was held last October at Brennan's Irish Pub in Youngstown. The event was again a big success for the Friends, netting \$533 in profit for the library.

Each event winner was a family affair - Kevin and his son Colin Winkworth won the men's team event and the mixed team event was won by Rick and Jen Russell - father and daughter competitors.

In addition to the billiards, spectators were able to enjoy pizza and wings in the company of friends.

A big Thank You goes out to Brennan's, Angelo Sarkees, who organized the tournament, as well as friends' board members Tom Patrick, Lynn Funk and Christine Foster. The Friends board is also very grateful to our local businesses for their support of our event with their generous donations of prizes and gift cards.

Fall Book Sale - November 7th - 9th, 2013

This fall saw one of the most successful book sales in recent years. Over the 2 ½ days of the sale, book sales grossed some \$1,698. Visitors to the sale were able to buy 50/50 tickets and were also encouraged to join the Friends of the Library. In total, \$1,804 was donated to the Youngstown Free Library.

Thank you to board member Jessica Streb for her organization and to all who volunteered their help with the event.
