FRIENDS' ANNUAL MEMBERSHIP RENEWAL

Thank you to everyone who has renewed their membership for 2016. We are so grateful for your support. To date this year, we have raised over \$4,800 in membership dues and have some 289 members.

All of your membership monies go to help the Friends support the library, by hosting fund-raisers and helping to purchase equipment and materials for the library that cannot be covered by the regular library budget. At the end of last year, we purchased new orange chairs for the Children's Room, an "AWE" After School Edge tablet (ask your library staff about this), some children's Playaway audio-player kits and we also funded this year's children's Summer Reading program and paid for the Sunday New York Times subscription. So you can see your membership dollars are put to good use.


START OF SUMMER STREET DANCE


